

DISCUSSION PAPER Board meeting – Wednesday 14th May 2018

Subject: Discussion paper 9 – the repair/decommission of various flower planters.

Decision to made:

To decide whether to repair/decommission the flower planters shown in the Appendix

Background

There are currently 26 wooden flower planters within the Kings Heath BID area that the responsibility of Kings Heath BID limited. Due to their design, they are prone to wet rot and warping.

The appendix shows 6 planters that need immediate attention. They are either in danger of collapsing onto members of the public, OR the internal wooden floor collapsing leaving us with an empty planter with no flowers

Based on the cost of repairing/decommissioning other planters, it will cost at most £80 per planter.

At the moment, each planter costs the BID:
£80 per year in planting flowers.
£65 per year to water.
